

Safe and Sane Fireworks

Safe and Sane fireworks may only be lawfully discharged in Huntington Beach within the following time period:


July 4th from 12:00 noon to 10:00 pm

The discharge of Safe and Sane fireworks during any other time is prohibited and subject to a \$500 fine for the first offense.

Other restrictions for the discharge of Safe and Sane fireworks include:

- Discharge of fireworks must be directly supervised by a person at least 18 years old.
- Discharge is prohibited in Districts 1, 2 and 3 of the Downtown Specific Plan (*see map on opposite side*).
- Discharge is prohibited in **all areas** on the ocean side of Pacific Coast Highway. This includes all beaches, parking lots and residential areas such as Sunset Beach.
- Discharge is prohibited in areas zoned as commercial, industrial and manufacturing.
- Discharge is prohibited on all public streets.
- Discharge is prohibited on all public parks.
- Discharge is prohibited on **any** public property. The only exception is for sidewalks and alleys in residential districts.
- Discharge of fireworks must be further than 10 feet from any residence, dwelling, structure or oil well.
- Permission must be obtained from the owner of any property on which fireworks are discharged.

All fireworks other than Safe and Sane are prohibited in all areas in Huntington Beach anytime during the year. A full listing of fireworks regulations in Huntington Beach can be found on the homepage of the city's website.



Discharge of Fireworks Prohibited in these areas

- Districts 1, 2 and 3 of the Downtown Specific Plan
- All areas on the ocean side of Pacific Coast Highway. This includes all beaches, parking lots and residential areas such as Sunset Beach.
