### **STATEMENT OF ISSUE:**

Since our Special Council Meeting held on Monday, July 28, 2014, information regarding alternative solutions to creating an exemption for regulation of real property in mobile/manufactured home parks has been presented and, in some cases, put into effect. Accordingly, it is our desire to repeal Resolutions 2014-51 through 2014-54 to remove the Ballot Measure related to Huntington Beach Charter Section 803 [exemption for regulation of real property in mobile/manufactured home parks] and reaffirm Resolutions 2014-45 through 2014-48.

### **RECOMMENDED ACTION:**

Approve a Resolution of the City of Huntington Beach to repeal Resolutions 2014-51 through 2014-54 to remove the Ballot Measure related to Huntington Beach Charter Section 803 [exemption for regulation of real property in mobile/manufactured home parks] and reaffirm Resolutions 2014-45 through 2014-48 calling for and consolidating the election, submitted measure related to Safe and Sane Fireworks, and set priorities.
