Statement of Issue, Funding Source, Recommended Action, Alternative Action(s), Analysis, Environmental Status, Attachment(s)

Statement of Issue: There is a need to establish fees for a pass for parking at the Huntington Central Park Sports Complex.

Funding Source: N/A

Recommended Action: Motion to:
Adopt Resolution No. 2005- 63 Amending Resolution No. 2003-65 Entitled, "A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Huntington Beach Establishing a Citywide User Schedule for Charges for Facility Rentals and Recreation Services" (Supplemental Fee Resolution No. 3) Relating to Fees for a Parking Pass for Parking at the Huntington Central Park Sports Complex.

Alternative Action(s): Do not establish a parking pass for the Sports Complex.

Analysis: City Council adopted Resolution No. 2004-67 on August 16, 2004, establishing a \$1 daily rate for parking at the new Huntington Central Park Sports Complex. The \$1 daily fee is for the park and pay machines at the complex. Staff recommends implementing a parking permit for the sports complex that can be purchased for the season and be permanently placed in the window of a car similar to the annual beach parking pass. pass would allow City of Huntington Beach softball players to park and go directly to their games, simplifying the process for regular Central Park Sports Complex patrons, while allowing visitors to the complex to use the existing park and pay machines.

Staff is recommending that the city fee resolution be amended to include a \$10 fee for a seasonal parking pass, and a \$30 fee for an annual pass (three seasons). To determine the appropriate fee to charge, all participants in the Adult Softball Program were surveyed. Eighty percent of the people surveyed play only one night a week, and 16 percent two nights a week. Teams are scheduled eleven weeks during the season and approximately 70 percent of their games are played at the sports complex. This breaks down on average to each team playing approximately eight games per season at the sports complex. Purchase of the pass would be optional. The parking pass would provide a convenience to the public without any projected loss of revenue at the sports complex.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the fee additions set out in this Supplemental Fee Resolution No. shall become effective immediately, and continue during the fiscal year 2005/06 and thereafter; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that except as amended herein, the fees contained in Resolution No. 2003-65, shall remain in full force and effect.
