Statement of Issue, Funding Source, Recommended Action, Alternative Action(s), Analysis, Environmental Status, Attachment(s)

Statement of Issue: Rainbow Disposal has offered to continue its donation of one additional collection of trash from the downtown sidewalk containers on scheduled weekend days (Friday-Sunday) for the six-month period from January 1, 2005 through June 30, 2005.

Funding Source: No funding is required. This is a donation of service valued at \$13,250.

Recommended Action: Motion to:

1. Accept Rainbow Disposal's offer to donate the cost for one additional trash collection on Friday and Saturday in January and February, and on Friday, Saturday and Sunday in March, April, May and June of 2005.
2. Revert to the pre-existing schedule after the six-month period expires.

Alternative Action(s):

Decline the offer; direct staff to contact Rainbow Disposal to discontinue the additional collections effective January 1, 2005, and revert to the pre-existing collection schedule for downtown.

Analysis: The City covers the cost for Rainbow Disposal to collect from 96 public receptacles along Pacific Coast Highway, Main Street and the adjoining streets in the downtown area at a rate of \$2 per receptacle. The schedule varies on a monthly basis to account for seasonal attendance in the downtown area. Attachment 1 shows the standard downtown collection schedule with the proposed additional donated collections noted in parenthesis.

At the May 17, 2004 City Council meeting, an action was approved to direct staff to accept Rainbow Disposal's offer of additional weekend downtown area trash collection from June through December, 2004. Collection services would revert to the standard schedule upon expiration of the donation period. Rainbow Disposal has offered to continue donating refuse collection one additional time on scheduled weekend days (Friday-Sunday) for six months. The value of this service is \$13,250.

Public Works Commission Action: Not required.

Environmental Status: Not applicable.
