Purpose of Study


- Measure current support for benefit assessment to fund street maintenance
- Identify the fee rate owners will support
- Identify projects owners are most interested in funding
- Expose owners to arguments about the measure
- Estimate support for the benefit assessment once owners are exposed to additional info



Methodology of Study

- Telephone survey
- 15 minutes
- Conducted Jan 21st to Jan 26th, 2012
- 400 residential property owners in the City
- Overall margin of error of $\pm 4.9\%$


Initial Ballot Test

In order to:

- Adequately repair and maintain residential streets in your neighborhood and major streets throughout the city, including fixing potholes, rebuilding damaged streets, and repaving streets
- And fix or replace damaged sidewalks, curbs, gutters and street trees








Interim Ballot Test




Negative Arguments

Key Conclusions

- Does an assessment measure appear feasible? *Yes.*
 - Maintaining local streets and roads is among the most important issue to residential property owners
 - Solid initial support for a measure
 - Popular projects/services
 - Compelling positive arguments

Caveats & Next Steps

➤ **Fee rate**

- Substantial sensitivity to the fee among residential property owners. Must set a rate owners view as affordable.

➤ **Stakeholder Strategy**

➤ **Assessment Engineering Study**


- Distinguishes special benefit from general benefit. Assessment pays for special benefit portion & City pays for general benefit portion.

➤ **Phase 2 Mail Survey Research**

- Need to understand how commercial, industrial and apartment owners will respond
- Simulates balloting & response bias

- Clear need to build and sustain support
