**ORDINANCE NO. 4062
Adopted by the City Council on JULY 20, 2015**

“AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON BEACH REPEALING SECTIONS 17.56.600 AND 17.56.610 OF THE HUNTINGTON BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS AND AMENDING SECTION 17.56.220 OF THE HUNTINGTON BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE TITLED WHERE REQUIRED”

SYNOPSIS:

With the repeal of Municipal Code Chapter 17.58 (Ordinance #4061), two sections of Chapter 17.56 that reference 17.58 were also recommended for repeal. With the revision of Municipal Code Section 17.56, additional language was added to allow Fire Code Officials to require businesses to maintain their business emergency plans and associated documentation in a key box. This will allow immediate access to maps, hazardous materials inventories and safety data sheets for emergency responders.
