**ORDINANCE NO. 4083
Adopted by the City Council on MARCH 21, 2016**

“AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON BEACH AMENDING SECTION 10.84.120 OF THE HUNTINGTON BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO IMPOUNDING PARKED BICYCLES”

SYNOPSIS:

The Police Department noticed an increase in bicycles left unattended for extended periods of time throughout the City. These bicycles have been left secured to public fences, City signs, and bicycle racks. The ordinance allows officers to impound these abandoned bicycles after placing a 72 hour notice on the bicycle. The bicycle will then be placed into property at the Police Department and held according to current law.
