NOTICE TO VOTERS OF DATE AFTER WHICH NO ARGUMENTS FOR OR AGAINST A CITY MEASURE (TO AMEND THE CITY CHARTER RELATING TO LEVY OF PROPERTY TAX FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES) MAY BE SUBMITTED TO THE CITY CLERK

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the General Municipal Election is to be held in the City of Huntington Beach on Tuesday, November 6, 2012, at which there will be submitted to the voters the following measure:

"Shall the proposed Charter Amendment, amending Section 607 of the Charter of the City of Huntington Beach entitled Tax Limits, as set forth in the proposed measure be approved?"	YES

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to Article 4, Chapter 3, Division 9, Section 9282(a) of the Elections Code of the State of California, for a measure placed on the ballot by petition, the person filing an initiative petition pursuant to this article may file a **written argument** in favor of the ordinance, and the legislative body may submit an argument against the ordinance, **not to exceed 300 words in length**, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that, based upon the time reasonably necessary to prepare and print the arguments and sample ballots for the election, **the City Clerk has fixed July 16, 2012, during normal office hours, as posted, as the date after which no arguments for or against the City measure to amend the Charter may be submitted to the clerk** for printing and distribution to the voters as provided in Article 4. Arguments shall be submitted to the City Clerk, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it at the City Hall, Huntington Beach, California. Arguments may be changed or withdrawn until and including the date fixed by the City Clerk.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the city council had determined that **rebuttal arguments, not to exceed 250 words in length**, as submitted by the authors of the opposing direct arguments, may be filed with the clerk, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, not more than 10 days after the final date for filing direct arguments. **The final date for rebuttals to be delivered to the City Clerk is July 26, 2012 at close of business day.**

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that any ordinance, impartial analysis, or direct argument filed under the authority of the elections code will be available for public examination in the clerk's office for not less than 10 calendar days from the deadline for the filing of the arguments and analysis. Any rebuttal argument filed under the authority of the elections code will be available for public examination in the clerk's office for not less than 10 calendar days from the deadline for filing rebuttal arguments.
