Magnolia Sidewalk – Todd Broussard

Todd Broussard provided a project overview of the Magnolia Sidewalk project that is proposed for Magnolia Street from the Flood Control Channel to Pacific Coast Highway. The project is currently budgeted at \$250,000 for studies, design and construction. Dave Webb encouraged input from the Huntington Beach Wetlands Conservancy in the project design as there may be boardwalk opportunities that might connect to their proposed trail system.

Support letters in favor of the project were received from The Huntington Beach Wetlands Conservancy and the Southeast Huntington Beach Neighborhood Association. The discussion included concerns about various lighting scenarios and sensitivity to the wetland environment, providing for pedestrian safety, wildlife observation areas, and maintenance. Mary Beth Broeren informed the committee about the various permits, approvals, and environmental documentation needed to process the project.

Hanson predicated that the project is dependent upon having funding available to proceed.

The meeting was adjourned approximately at 4:30 pm.
