The meeting was called to order at 3:40 pm.

Public Comments:

- Jerry Dominguez, Southern California Edison, will be meeting with Travis Hopkins, City Engineer, regarding the 20a Undergrounding Project. He reported that sections of Brookhurst and Edinger are planned for the future. In addition, 50 streetlight pole replacements will be made from metal to concrete.
- Jack Kirkhorn reported that the areas along PCH looks better.
- Carol Runzel reported that AES is interested in the Adopt-A-Highway Program. Currently all segments between the Santa Ana River and Newland are adopted or are in the process of being adopted.

Magnolia Sidewalk – Todd Broussard, Principal Civil Engineer

Todd reported that the budget for the Magnolia sidewalk project has been updated to approximately \$430,000. In the draft budget for 06/07, \$310,000 is being proposed from the Southeast Coastal Redevelopment Area funds for this project. The project will include removing existing barriers, installing curb and gutter, sidewalk, fencing, and pedestrian lighting on both sides. The committee agreed to fund the entire project from the Southeast Coastal Redevelopment Area funding.

Upon the suggestion of Don Hansen, and agreement from other committee members and staff, the future meetings will commence at 4:00 PM.

The meeting was adjourned approximately at 4:00 pm.
