#### A. ORAL COMMUNICATIONS

Brian Bailey, resident, spoke regarding the lights at Brethren Christian High School, indicating that he would appreciate details on the project's status. Chair Farley stated that staff would contact Mr. Bailey with that information.

Connie Boardman, resident, spoke in opposition to Commissioner Delgleize's statements regarding opponents of The Ridge project.

Alicia Waterhouse, resident, spoke in opposition to the lights at Brethren Christian High School. She noted that Brethren Christian High School has repeatedly violated the conditions of approval for the project and encouraged the commission to hold a revocation hearing or utilize some other enforcement measure .

Terry Crowther, Neighborhoods for Safety and Quality, spoke in opposition to the lights at Brethren Christian High School and asked that Neighborhoods for Safety and Quality be included in any meetings regarding the project.

Gary Worthington, resident, spoke in opposition to the lights at Brethren Christian High School and expressed disappointment that the lights were initially permitted.

Herb Fauland, Planning Manager, stated that a status update on the Brethren Christian High School lights would be held at the July 27, 2010, study session. He noted that staff was in discussions with Brethren Christian to relocate the four city owned lights.

#### **FINDINGS FOR PROJECTS EXEMPT FROM CEQA:**

The Planning Commission finds that the proposed project will not have any significant effect on the environment and is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to City Council Resolution No. 4501, Class 5, which supplements the California Environmental Quality Act because the request is a minor street vacation.

#### **FINDINGS OF APPROVAL- GENERAL PLAN CONFORMANCE NO. 10-001**

1. The vacation of a City owned highway slope easement and the transfer of ownership through a Quit Claim action conforms to the following goals and objective of the Land Use and Circulation Elements of the General Plan:
  - a. LU Goal 2: *Ensure that development is adequately served by transportation infrastructure, utility infrastructure, and public services.*
  - b. CE Goal 2: *Provide a circulation system, which supports existing, approved, and planned land uses throughout the City while maintaining a desired level of service on all streets and at all intersections.*
  - c. Objective CE 1.1: *Balance the circulation system with the circulation demands generated by the implementation of the City's Land Use Element.*

The public improvement to widen Newland Street and raise the grade of the adjacent property along Newland Street created improved vehicular circulation. Therefore, the slope easement is no longer necessary to achieve required efficient circulation.
