SUBJECT: Advertise Sewer Lift Station #26 Rebuild, CC-1277

Statement of Issue: Plans and specifications for Sewer Lift Station #26 Rebuild CC1277, are in final preparation. Staff requests recommendation of this project to the City Council.

Funding Source: Funds are budgeted in the Sewer Service Charge Fund, Sewer Lift Station 51189001. The engineer's cost estimate for this project is \$2,100,000 for the construction of Lift Station #26.

Recommended Action: Motion to recommend to the City Council Sewer Lift Station #26 Rebuild, CC-1277.

Alternative Action(s): Deny approval and recommend an alternate action.

Analysis: Sewer Lift Station #26, the Brighton Sewer Lift Station, was originally constructed in 1972. The wet well was expanded in 1989 to accommodate additional development. The existing lift station is located at the intersection of Brighton Drive and Shoreham Lane, adjacent to Bolsa View Park in the southwest part of Huntington Beach.


Lift Station #26 is demonstrating signs of deterioration, due to age and proximity to the marine environment and is need of replacement. This project will abandon the existing lift station and force main and replace it with a new station and force main.
