Learn how this typical lawn became an **Ocean Friendly Garden (OFG)** that “applied CPR:”

C - Conservation - properly-spaced native & climate appropriate plants;

P - Permeability - healthy soil, mulch and hardscape directs water into garden;

R - Retention - directing rain gutters into mulch and “swale trail” crossing the garden.

A turf removal rebate from Metropolitan Water Districts of Orange County partially covered the costs. The owners will tell us how they did it, and have invited the landscape professionals involved. Then we’ll walk the neighborhood, using OFG Sign Criteria to see who else has OFG elements. We’ll leave behind a flyer for those close to being OFG and see if they want help.


