



The City of Huntington Beach has over \$65 million in Capital Improvement Projects scheduled through 2008. Projects are planned throughout the city according to need and available funding. Included in the above map are:

- **Streets and transportation \$20 million**
 - Arterial rehabilitation
 - Slurry seal and overlay residential street
 - Widen Newland Avenue south of Hamilton Street
 - Widen Garfield Avenue at Delaware Street
 - Concrete repairs to eight residential streets
 - Street and alley repairs Downtown
 - Landscape Brookhurst Street frontage road near Yorktown Avenue
- **Public facilities \$14 million**
 - Install energy efficient cool roof at Central Library
 - Improve accessibility at Main Street Library and Art Center
 - Remodel fire stations
 - Repair the Oak View gym
- **Parks, beaches and recreation \$13 million**
 - Planning Edison Park Youth Sports Improvements
 - Additional Landscaping along Bluff Top Park
 - Design permanent buildings on the Pier
 - Design new Senior Center
- **Sewer stations and lines \$10 million**
 - Rebuild a sewer lift station
 - Complete lift station/sewer line near Warner Avenue and Los Patos
- **Water lines and facilities \$9 million**
 - Corrosion control
 - Water line replacement
 - Upgrade remote facilities monitoring
 - Design utilities yard and building improvements
