

SUBJECT: Construct Curb Access Ramps at Various Locations, MSC 470

Statement of Issue: Plans and specifications are in final preparation for MSC 470, Construct Curb Access Ramps at Various Locations. Staff is seeking support for the project and the initiation of the competitive bid process.

Funding Source: Funds in the amount of \$56,837 are budgeted in Community Development Block Grant Funds, ADA Streets, Account 85982010.82300. The engineer's cost estimate for this project is \$56,350 which includes standard contingency expenses.

Impact on Future Maintenance Costs: There is no anticipated impact on future maintenance costs.

Recommended Action: Motion to recommend to the City Council MSC 470, Construct Curb Access Ramps at Various Locations.

Alternative Action(s): Deny approval and advise staff as to preferred alternative.


Analysis: In 2008, the Public Works Department was awarded funding under the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) in an amount sufficient to construct 20 curb access ramps to transition from sidewalk to street in locations where no such ramps exist. Construction of curb access ramps furthers compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act. The ramp locations are based on a list compiled from resident requests, the oldest of which date back to 2006. A vicinity map and specific location maps for the proposed ramps are attached. This project, if approved, will complete ramp requests received through 2007.


I-12



MSC 470 VICINITY MAP


