



Education

Oak View community, Huntington Beach, Calif.



- **81% increase in API** at Oak View Elementary since 1999 (first year it was measured). 1999 API was 421. 2011 API is 760. The state target is a minimum of 800 for all schools.
- The API is based on the results of state standardized tests in English-language arts, math, and science.




- Population 25 or older who have not graduated or obtained a GED divided by total population.



Health

Oak View community, Huntington Beach, Calif.



- Childhood obesity is defined as Body Mass Index for age >95th percentile on the pediatric growth chart set by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.




- Children receive a score based on aerobic capacity, body composition, abdominal strength, trunk extensor strength, upper body strength, and flexibility. The scores are then averaged.



- Average household size is calculated by dividing the population by households.

- (Housing units = all types of housing including detached homes.)





- Per capita income is derived by dividing the total income of all people 15 years old and over in an area by the total population in that area.






Public Safety
