**Fountain Valley School District** – Dr. Marc Ecker reported:

- Asst. Superintendent is Cypress Superintendent
- 19 FV kids won awards at the OC Science Fair
- “Makes Challenge” 3-D printer made prototype of hand to pick-up garbage
- Gold Ribbon Schools in FV – 100% of Schools participated
- Aging School sites – put together a group of stakeholders to look at FV facilities to create a vision for the future
- Schools out on 6/17
- Ian Collins thanked Community Services Department for the CNTF Youth Character Awards

**HB City School District** – Gregg Haulk reported:

- The District Office has moved to a temporary location for approximately 18 months
- Working with the City of HB to ensure that fields are still available for the youth baseball program
- Will be rebuilding at Kettler School at a zero cost to the General Fund
- LeBard will be bid and sold in the fall – preschool “Summer Academy”

**HB Union High School District** – Dr. Greg Plutko reported:

- 16,000 teens
- Thanked the City for their support of schools – primarily HBPD support for the schools
- Graduation this week – Wednesday and Thursday, 4 p.m. – 5 p.m.
- Grad Nights was discussed – many times the grad nights are all night events
- 2004 passed a Bond for the HS Districts – The District has refinanced those Bonds in order to provide a savings to the Community of approximately \$29M

**Ocean View School District** – Gustavo Balderas reported:

- They are actively seeking a replacement for his position by mid July
- 3 schools that are closed for asbestos clean-up will reopen, Hope View by mid Summer, Oak View by school year start in portables and Lake View TBD

Trustee Briscoe added:

- City will need to respond to the Public Records Act – His request for “Safe Routes to Schools”
- Trash collection bids for OVSD collection resulted in a savings
