Pharmacy Robberies - Oxycontin Targeted

DATE: Sunday, November 4th 1712 hrs & 1917 hours

LOCATIONS: 19582 Beach Blvd, CVS Pharmacy (RD 422)
17522 Beach Blvd, Walgreens (RD 283)

SUSPECTS: Male, White, 25-30, 5'11" - 6'01", 160-175 lbs, skull tattoo on right arm, tattoos on hands and knuckles, and both forearms

There were two robberies on the same day involving the above listed suspect. Below is a brief synopsis:

The suspect enters CVS at 1712 hours and walks towards the pharmacy. He grabs a piece of paper and scribbles a demand note "Give me all of your oxy contin 80 mg and vicotan." He handed the note to the pharmacist who read the note and stared at the suspect. The suspect then yelled that he would kill him! The suspect then put his hand in his pocket and simulated a gun. The pharmacist saw that it was a lighter and refused. The suspect punches the pharmacist in the shoulder. The suspect continued to demand the drugs and the pharmacist stated the police were on the way. He fled the location.

In the second case, the same suspect enters Walgreens at 1926 hours and walks up to the pharmacist and demands Oxycontin. The suspect put his hand in his pocket simulating a weapon. A weapon was not seen during the robbery. The pharmacist fearing for his safety gave the suspect a partially filled bottle of 5mg Oxycodone. The suspect fled the scene.
