DETAILS: On 04-16-10, at approximately 9:15 AM, a male suspect entered the Bank of America at 18691 Main Street, Huntington Beach. He approached a teller and presented a demand note for money. The teller gave the suspect an unknown amount of cash, and the suspect fled the bank out the front door. The suspect was last seen running through the parking lot, away from the bank.

At approximately 10:10 AM a police officer stopped a subject a short distance from the bank. During an interview, the officer developed information of a possible suspect in an apartment in the 7500 block of Ellis. The apartment was contained and people inside the residence contacted by phone. At the request of the officers, the occupants exited the apartment. During the investigation at

the apartment, the robbery suspect was identified as Daniel Morrison who was taken into custody without incident. Evidence was recovered in the apartment linking the suspect to the robbery. The investigation is continuing at this time.
