Fatal Traffic Collision – Beach Boulevard, North of Heil Avenue

On Tuesday, February 8, 2022, at approximately 6:30 p.m., the Huntington Beach Police Department (HBPD) responded to a traffic collision on Beach Boulevard, north of Heil Avenue involving a pedestrian and a silver 2004 Toyota Corolla.

Upon arrival, officers located the pedestrian, an unknown female, deceased in the roadway. The driver of the Corolla, a 76-year old female, remained at the scene and fully cooperated with officers. It does not appear that drugs or alcohol were a factor in the collision.

Based on the preliminary investigation, the Corolla was traveling southbound on Beach Boulevard and struck the pedestrian who was in the roadway, outside of the crosswalk, north of Heil Avenue.

The collision investigation is ongoing and being handled by the HBPD Multidisciplinary Accident Investigation Team (MAIT).
