Details:

On December 3rd, 2013, at about 6:30 PM, the Huntington Beach Police Department responded to the area of Springdale Street and Glenwood Drive regarding a hit and run collision involving a vehicle and a pedestrian.

Arriving officers located a 57 year old male in the roadway. He was seriously injured and was treated by Orange County Fire Authority personnel. He was ultimately transported to UCI Medical Center where he was admitted in critical condition.

A citizen in the area indicated the involved vehicle had left the scene of the collision. While officers were still at the scene investigating the incident, they were contacted by a 65 year old male who indicated he was the driver of the vehicle involved in the collision. The driver was uninjured. The suspect vehicle was located in the area with evidence linking it to the collision.

Based on the preliminary investigation, it appears the 65 year old male was driving a black sedan southbound on Springdale and collided with the 57 year old male pedestrian who was in the roadway.

The 65 year old male was interviewed and ultimately arrested for hit and run and suspicion of DUI.

HBPD Accident Reconstruction Officers responded to the collision scene and conducted the initial investigation. This is an ongoing investigation and the Huntington Beach Police Department is seeking witnesses regarding this incident.
