Details:

On May 7, 2013, at about 2:40 AM, the Huntington Beach Police Department received a report of a traffic collision on Beach Boulevard north of Edinger Avenue. The arriving officers discovered the pedestrian victim, a 34 year old female, injured and unconscious in the roadway.

Initial investigation shows the pedestrian was walking east across Beach Boulevard under the 405 Freeway overpass, when she was struck by a white 2013 Honda Accord being driven by a 36 year old male from Garden Grove. The Honda had been travelling north on Beach Boulevard. After being struck by the Honda, the pedestrian got up and ran south on Beach Boulevard, where she was struck a second time by a blue 2002 Dodge Caravan being driven by a 26 year old male from Huntington Beach. The Dodge also had been travelling north on Beach Boulevard.

The female pedestrian sustained serious injuries and was treated on scene by Huntington Beach Fire Department paramedics. She was transported to a near by hospital, where she remained in critical condition.

HBPD Accident Reconstruction Officers responded to the collision scene and conducted the initial investigation. This is an ongoing investigation and the Huntington Beach Police Department is seeking witnesses regarding this incident.
