### **Details:**

On the date and time a uniformed Huntington Beach Police Officer contacted two males in a vehicle on the corner of Glencoe Drive and Silver Lane. The males exited the vehicle and ran from the officer. The officer chased one suspect. There was a confrontation that resulted in an officer involved shooting. The suspect, a male adult, was shot and killed at the scene. The officer was not injured. A handgun has been recovered from the suspect at the scene. At this time there is no known motive for the suspect's actions.

The second suspect fled north on Sher Lane and is described as a male Hispanic early 20's, 6 feet tall weighing 200 pounds with a shaved head. He was dressed in all black clothing. He is wanted for questioning at this time.

The Orange County Sheriff's Homicide Unit has responded and per our policy will be conducting the investigation. We are asking that all follow up inquiries be addressed to their press information officer.

The Huntington Beach Police Officer involved in the shooting is a 9 year law enforcement veteran. We are not releasing the identity of the officer or deceased suspect at this time.
