Details:

On October 26, 2011, at about 7:20 PM, the Huntington Beach Police Department received a report of a traffic collision at Yorktown Avenue and England Street. The arriving officers discovered a 1997 blue Toyota sedan had struck a pedestrian, who was in the roadway. The female pedestrian, who was about 70 years old, was walking across Yorktown Avenue, when the collision occurred. The female pedestrian's name will not be released until there is verification of her identify and notification of her next of kin.

The victim was treated at the scene by Huntington Beach Fire Department paramedics and transported to the UCI Medical Center. After being transported to the hospital, the victim died of apparent injuries caused by the collision.

There was no indication alcohol played a role in this collision. No arrest or citation has been issued at this time, but this is still an ongoing investigation. The Huntington Beach Police Department is requesting anyone who witnessed this collision, who was not already interviewed, to call Officer Barr at 714-536-5666.
