Huntington Beach Police to Conduct Sobriety Checkpoint

As the Christmas and New Years holiday's approach, the Huntington Beach Police Department will be making an extra effort to keep our streets safe for everyone. Officers will be conducting a sobriety checkpoint on Friday, December 15, 2006.

It is the hope of the department's Traffic Bureau to avoid serious injury and fatal collisions throughout the holiday season by interdicting DUI drivers before they have the chance to cause a tragedy. The Huntington Beach Police Department believes that a combination of prevention and enforcement will save lives, making our community a better place to live and work.
