

RESOLUTION NO. 6320

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON BEACH AMENDING CHAPTER 1.04, SECTION 1.04.12 OF RESOLUTION NO. 6085 - "A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON BEACH ADOPTING A REVISED COUNCIL MANUAL"

The City Council of the City of Huntington Beach does hereby amend Chapter 1.04, Section 1.04.12 of Resolution No. 6085 to read as follows:

CHAPTER 1.04

Parliamentary Procedure

1.04.12 Procedure for Selection of the Mayor and Mayor Pro Tempore

The procedure for selection of the Mayor and Mayor Pro Tempore, pursuant to Charter Sections 305 and 306, shall be as follows:

- (a) At the City Council meeting following any general or special municipal election at which any council member is installed, or as soon thereafter as the results of the election are certified, the City Council shall elect a Mayor and a Mayor Pro Tempore. In non-election years, the selection of Mayor and Mayor Pro Tempore shall be made at the City Council meeting date closest to the anniversary date of the selections in the election years.
- (b) The Mayor and Mayor Pro Tempore shall serve terms of one year.

(c) The member of the City Council serving as Mayor Pro Tempore shall become the Mayor on the expiration of the Mayor's term.


(d) The member of the City Council having the longest consecutive City Council service shall become the Mayor Pro Tempore.

(1) In the event that two City Council members have the same length of service, then the member who received the greatest number of votes in the last Council election in which such member was elected shall become Mayor Pro Tempore.

(2) If any member declines his/her term as it arises in rotation, that member shall remain in the same place in the rotation cycle as if he/she had served.


(3) Any City Council member who has served as Mayor within the last four years will not be eligible for election as Mayor Pro Tempore.


