The Environmental Board in conjunction with the City Council will present the **FIFTEENTH ANNUAL AWARDS AND RECOGNITION PROGRAM** on **Monday, January 17, 2011.** Additionally, submissions should be based on active environmental innovation, preservation, energy efficiency, conservation or restoration, recycling and waste reduction or education.
