Beach Information



CITY BEACH

Encompassing 3.5 miles from Beach Boulevard to the west city limits, the city boasts one of the world's finest beaches. The beachfront includes the municipal pier, food and rental concessions, restrooms, showers, volleyball nets, fire rings, and a 2,200 space beach parking lot plus additional parking on Pacific Coast Highway and adjacent streets. Lifeguard service is provided during all daylight hours 365 days a year. The number of lifeguards on duty varies depending upon weather and surf conditions. Curfew is 10:00 pm to 5:00 am and is strictly enforced. Beach Headquarters: 103 Pacific Coast Highway. Office hours: Monday - Friday, 8:00 am - 5:00 pm. Phone: 714-536-5281. Emergencies: call 911.
