Dear Neighbor,

In follow up to our recent letter, we would like to report that the California Energy Commission (CEC) has approved our request for a limited work crew to work extended hours (up to 24 hours a day), if necessary, to relocate high voltage lines out of the way of our new construction project at the AES Huntington Beach Generating Station.

We will be moving on-site transmission lines that connect the existing generating units to the electrical grid and installing a new steel power pole. To do so safely, we must take the existing plant *temporarily* out of service. **Please note that this outage will have no impact on your power service.**

To ensure that we complete the line relocation during this *limited* outage, we may need to work extended hours, which means working outside of our normal construction hours of 7 a.m. to 8 p.m., Monday through Saturday. *Any after-hours work will be related to the time-sensitive, line relocation project only.. The offsite parking and construction laydown areas on Newland Street and Magnolia Street will not be used after hours.*

Thank you for your patience as we work as quickly and safely as possible to complete this important project.
