### Contest Rules

1. Contest open to all high school students who live in or attend school in HBUHSD.
2. Entries must reflect an aspect of a student exchange with a student in Japan.
3. Entries must be of original design and not infringe on any copyrights.
4. Entries must be clearly marked for identification.
5. Entries must be no larger than 9" x 12".

### **Theme**

This contest is designed to make students aware of the opportunity of the Sister City Student Exchange Program in the summer of 2018. Through a reciprocal family living experience, families host a student from Japan for two weeks and our students travel to Japan for two weeks. The Sister City Association of Huntington Beach has conducted this successful exchange for 35 years.

What do you think this experience would be like? How are Japanese students different from those in California? How are they the same? Is there a difference in American and Japanese schools? What would you like to see in Japan? What would it be like to be in a home where little English is spoken?

### **Media**

Use watercolors, oil paints, tempera, markers, crayons, chalk, or colored pencils. Artwork may be realistic or abstract. Media should be colorful and reproduce well.
