My name is Amory Hanson and I am a candidate for the Huntington Beach City Council 2016 election. I would like to provide a darker, grimmer side of the homelessness problem. As a bus passenger, I have experienced several incidents with the homeless. These range from public urination to a full-fledged assault against an Orange County Transportation Authority bus driver. I now must stand up for the victims of homeless people. No one else has stood up for them.

I would express my admiration for the compassion of the chairman and the task force. I would especially like to express my admiration for the compassion of the vice-chairman. However, my compassion died a week ago, following more incidents involving the homeless.

I now believe the only way to solve the homeless problem is by punitive measures. The homeless are not your average people, and they have no humanity. Do we play nice with people with homes who commit crimes? My experience shows that homeless people are more likely to commit crimes. I did not witness an assault until I started riding the bus with the homeless. I would suggest that the homelessness task force take a field trip on the 1 bus as part of their "inquiry" prior to making any recommendations.

It is unfortunate that it has come to this. But we have to do something. We have to make clear actions have consequences and save this city before it is too late.
