

- You can also report issues online at huntingtonbeachca.gov by clicking “I Want To” and choosing the subject under the “Report” heading.
- This allows direct interaction with those who are tasked with handling the problem. GPS features assist responders with precise location information.
- This is not designed for situations of imminent peril. Use 911 in a true emergency.
