



Atlanta Avenue Widening Project (Huntington St. to Delaware St.)

As part of Huntington Beach's ongoing efforts to improve the city's circulation, the city is planning to widen Atlanta Avenue. This project will be done in phases to limit the impact on your residence and access from Atlanta Avenue will be limited during this project.

Your cooperation is appreciated during the time necessary for the work to be performed. Your patience will be rewarded by a new street, landscaping, block wall and additional on-site parking.

This contractor is scheduled to mobilize as soon as May 6, 2019 and the project is anticipated to be completed by January, 2020.



Please expect the following phases in the project:

1

Phase One:

A fence will be installed around the perimeter of the project site. The area will be cleared to allow for the construction to begin.

Phase Two:

Work within the mobile home park will begin. Utilities will be relocated within the mobile home park and a new retaining wall will be constructed. Residents will be notified in advance of any known utility outages.




CONSTRUCTION DETAILS:
