**POLICE DEPARTMENT REPORT** – Chief Handy

Chief Handy reported that although HBPD has encountered opioid use, they have not documented overdoses specifically due to opioid use by people less than 18 years of age.

PD is working on acquiring a new type of software that will help to track/categorize a variety of drug uses. This will allow PD to create statistics that can identify the type of drug use related to each incident.

The chief reported that Dan Bryan from HBUHSD participated in the Sergeant interviews for HBPD, and thanked him for his service.
