POLICE DEPARTMENT REPORT: – No report

ROUND TABLE DISCUSSION:

Coast Community College District – Wes Bryant reported the following:

Huntington Beach district with Coast Community take classes concurrently either at High School or at the College. No priority for concurrent class. Serves two kinds of students: transfer student and remedial needs to get these students ready.

This has increase communication and cooperation between districts. Council Member Hardy commented that her experience with this has been positive and beneficial. Discussion ensued with most questions about general education classes and admittance and comments with regards to this program providing positive options.

Fountain Valley School District – No report

HB City School District – Jon Archibald reported the following:

Archibald thanked the HBPD Homeless Officers for their assistance at Kettler School with a recent encampment. HBPD was able to work with these individuals to transition them to another location.

HB Union High School District – Introduction of Superintendent Dr. Clint Harwick who reported the following:

Harwick expressed gratitude with his appointment noting that his previous assignment was with Saddleback Unified School District. He discussed plans to update three pools

(Edison, Marina and Fountain Valley High Schools) with no priority at this juncture. Westminster High School is already in process of being updated.

Harwick briefly discussed various factors to be considered when determining the size of pools, funding and costs. Peterson commented on his some of his experiences with the water polo program. Discussion ensued about potential partnerships with the community and the City including the possibility of naming opportunities.

Brenden inquired about funding options; Harwick replied that they are looking at the detail now.

Ocean View School District – Michael Conroy reported the following: Conroy mentioned that the district will hold two study sessions to discuss priorities for bond funds. Litigation has been settled with Rainbow and yielding about \$4M for construction of a Gymnasium at Oak View School
