**POLICE DEPARTMENT REPORT:**

Chief Handy reported the following:

- HBPD has been working closely with all of the Districts in preparation for the Wednesday, March 14<sup>th</sup> events related to the Florida school shooting. The plan is to have Detectives at the schools in uniform as well as the SRO's in a show of support.
- Chief Handy reported that since the shooting in Florida, there have been a number of threats made to our local schools, and it is tapering off.
- The Chief reported that there was an incident after school hours at Edison High School the previous Friday night that involved a female being stabbed by a suspect.
- HBPD is working on a gang intervention program that they are hoping to roll out soon, as there has been an uptick in gang activity around the Oakview area and they want to be proactive in their response.

**HB City School District** – Gregory Haulk, Superintendent

Superintendent Haulk reported the following:

- Both Dwyer and Hewes will be under construction. There will be temporary portables placed at Haas over the summer and half of the school will be worked on at a time.
- Additionally, Kettler school will be transformed into the District offices, work to take place this coming summer. The District will be reaching out to the City to discuss the potential of driveway access at the back of the site in order to access a parking lot that would then also be available to the public during non-school hours.

**HB Union High School District** – Dr. Dan Bryan

Dr. Bryan reported the following:

- Their C&G stations are increasing.
- They are in the accreditation visit process for Huntington High
- During the “17 minutes” demonstration on Wednesday they expect that all students would stay on campus, Dr. Bryan was also very complimentary about the assistance received from HBPD regarding the demonstration and safety plans.

**Ocean View School District** – Jack Souders, School Board President

Mr. Souders reported the following:

- The District is working on a Central Kitchen that will serve all schools in the District.
- This summer work will start on a new gym at Oakview.
- The modernization project will be starting at College View and Westmont and the students will be transferred to other schools during this process. Currently the District is conducting surveys to ascertain whether or not bussing will be needed during this process.

Councilmember Hardy reported on the Following:

- Youth in Government Day is scheduled for March 20<sup>th</sup>, she is very pleased with the level of leadership that is emerging from the participating schools on the Youth Board. Councilmember Hardy announced that the Youth Board would be hosting a forum after the March for our Lives event on March 24<sup>th</sup> at City Hall that will feature speakers on both sides of the issue.

- Councilmember Hardy posed a question to the group if this committee should be involved in some way in a conversation next year regarding a more coordinated timing of spring break as some schools take the week before Easter off and others the week after Easter and that is difficult for families with children in two schools.
