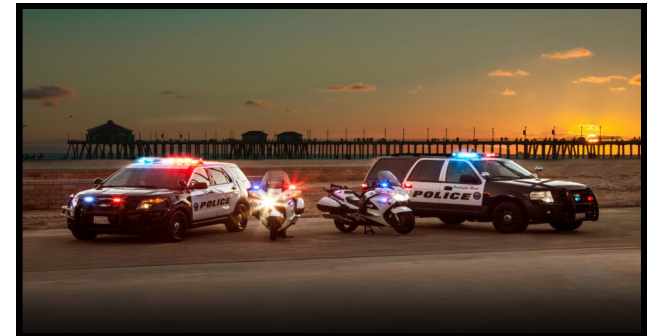

The Huntington Beach Police Department is proud to offer the Citizens Academy to local residents. The program is designed to increase the understanding of the Police Department.

The academy is offered in two sessions; one in the spring and one in the fall, running 12 consecutive Wednesday evenings from 6:30 pm to 9:30 pm. (The Spanish academy is held on Tuesday evenings at the same times.)

Students will learn from department personnel who are experts in the areas of Patrol and Traffic operations, Community-Oriented Policing, Narcotics, Vice, Gangs, SWAT, K-9, Aero Operations and other fields.

Whether you are a community leader, a long term resident, new resident, or live outside the city but work in the City of Huntington Beach, your attendance is welcome. The only additional requirements are that you must be at least eighteen years of age, have no outstanding warrants for your arrest, and no pending criminal cases.
