Subject: Fatal Traffic Collision

Details:

On Tuesday, February 14, 2017 at 8:38 PM, the Huntington Beach Police Department responded to the area of Pacific Coast Highway and Newland St regarding a traffic collision involving a vehicle and a pedestrian.

Arriving officers located a female pedestrian, 46 year old resident of Huntington Beach, in need of medical attention and paramedics were requested. The female was transported to UCI Medical Center where she succumbed to her injuries. Her name will not be released until next of kin can be notified.

The involved driver, 81 year old male resident of Seal Beach, remained at scene and was cooperative. He was driving a Red 2006 Toyota Sienna.

Based on the preliminary investigation, it appears the vehicle was traveling west on Pacific Coast Highway and struck the female pedestrian walking north in the intersection with Newland St.

The investigation is ongoing and is being conducted by the HBPD Major Incident Response Team (M.I.R.T). No citations have been issued and no arrests have been made at this time.
