Huntington Beach Police Department Responds to Shooting in Downtown Area

On Tuesday, October 5, 2021, at approximately 11:40 p.m., the Huntington Beach Police Department (HBPD) responded to reports of gunshots in downtown Huntington Beach in the area of 3rd Street and Walnut Avenue.

Upon arrival, officers located two adult males suffering from gunshot wounds. These individuals were transported to a local hospital, their condition is currently unknown but both are expected to survive.

A short time later, officers initiated a vehicle stop near the shooting location where they located five individuals matching the description of the suspected shooters. All five individuals were arrested and were brought to the Huntington Beach Police Station for further questioning. At this time, there is no outstanding public safety threat.

The investigation into the incident is still ongoing, however the preliminary investigation suggests that an argument and physical altercation had taken place between the two groups shortly before the shooting.
