DETAILS: On March 20, 2010, at approximately 6:18 p.m. Officers from the Huntington Beach Police Department and Huntington Beach Fire Department personnel responded to a single car injury traffic accident on Goldenwest and Pecan.

Emergency personnel located a red Dodge Viper on the raised center median against a tree. Fire Department personnel had to use heavy rescue equipment to gain access to the driver and passenger due to the extensive damage. The driver, Terry Stepp was immediately

removed from the wreckage and transported to University of California, Irvine Medical Center. The passenger, David Kerr was pronounced dead at the scene. Later on that evening Terry Stepp died as a result of his injuries while at the hospital.

It appears that the driver was travelling northbound on Goldenwest in the number 3 lane at a high rate of speed when for unknown reasons he lost control and crashed into a tree located on the center median.

The accident is still under investigation by Investigator Fulton. (714.536.5663)
