area. The driver then began driving recklessly and chasing children in the area. Officers arrived in the area and located the listed vehicle being driven by Martinez through the residential tract. Officers attempted to conduct a traffic stop on Martinez and he accelerated away refusing to stop. A three minute pursuit ensued with officers chasing Martinez until he attempted to make a turn into the Loews parking lot on B Street north of Warner. At that time an officer involved shooting occurred and Martinez was taken into custody. Neither Martinez nor the officers were injured in the shooting.
