On 09-28-06, at approximately 6:35 am, officers of the Huntington Beach Police Department responded to the intersection of Warner and Newland, reference an injury traffic collision.

Preliminary investigation indicates that a blue Ford van, was traveling westbound on Warner. A black Suzuki, Forenza and a White Honda were traveling southbound on Newland. A collision occurred between the Ford and the Suzuki. This caused the Suzuki swerve into the adjacent lane where it was struck in the side by the Honda.

The driver of the Suzuki, a 16 year old female resident of Westminster, sustained head trauma and possible internal injuries. She was treated at the scene by paramedics of the Huntington Beach Fire Department, and transported to UCI via ambulance. At this time she is listed in critical condition, undergoing treatment in the emergency room. There were no other injuries reported.

No citations have been issued at this time and there was no evidence of any alcohol involved. It appears that all drivers were wearing seatbelts at the time of the collision.
